Fodd bynnag, roedd wedi siarad ag aelod arall o'r tîm sy'n gyfarwydd â'r ardal a chafodd wybod nad eu cyfrifoldeb nhw yw'r safle ac nad oedd y safle wedi'i gofrestru â Chofrestrfa Tir EM. Felly, gan nad dyma eu hased, ni fyddent yn barod i ariannu unrhyw gynllun i unioni'r materion ymsuddiant. BODORGAN COMMUNITY COUNCIL.

Minutes of the Full Council Meeting held virtually on Tuesday, 14th NOVEMBER 2023.

1 PRESENT were:

Councillors Mr Tim Owen (Chairman), Mr Andrew Hughes, Mrs Sharon Barton, Mr Selwyn Williams, Mr Gwilym Looms, Mr Les Thomas Mr Myfyr Davies, Mr Gary Evans, Mr Alan Smith, Mrs Pat Dobbie and Mr J Alun Foulkes (Clerk).

2 Apologies for ABSENCE:

Apologies were received from: County Councilor Mr John Ifan Jones

3 Welcome:

The Chairman welcomed the Councilors and members of the Public to the meeting.

4 Declaration of Personal or Prejudicial Interest.

No personal and/or prejudicial interest was declared before the start of the meeting.

5 Correction & Approval of Minutes of Previous Meetings.

5.1 **Full Council Meeting – 19/9 /2023 - *Motion (AH) and Second (MD) that the minutes be approved as correct.***

5.2 **Footpaths Committee Meeting – 17/10/2023 - *Motion (SB) and Second (LT) that the minutes be approved as correct.***

6 Improvements to B4422 near Maes Glas Estate, Bethel, Bodorgan

Mr Trefor Owen, a resident of Maes Glas, was welcomed to the meeting so that he could share a report and summary of all correspondence between him and the IACC Highways Department. Historical issues were identified and what has been said for over a year now including a Feasibility Study carried out around the site in November 2022. Members of the Community Council and County Councillors continued to be completely supportive of seeing that there is an improvement in order to protect the site but that funding is the only difficulty at the moment.

Motion (AH) & Second (MD) to give the Clerk powers to act to arrange a meeting between him, Mr Owen and the County Councillors as the first step in order to make further progress in the matter.

7 The County Councillor's Report.

County Councillor Mr Arfon Wyn gave a verbal report on the following local issues:

- . **Bodorgan Train Station Signs and Platform** - attention has been made to erecting suitable signs indicating that there is a Train Station in Bodorgan and a meeting had been held with the Minister of Transport requesting that the height of the Platform be raised.
- . A number of applications were received for Memorial Benches along the Cob.
- . Following conversations with the IOACC, report and explanation was provided that there is uncertainty surrounding the ownership of the green space area and the Cob Car Park
- . A New Bin has finally been installed in Bethel near the Bus Shelter.
- . Requests and many applications received for Affordable Housing in the Area - some residents feel that these properties do not remain affordable for a long period of time.
- . Report following a meeting with Dr Wyn Morgan that funding has been set aside by Menter Môn to extend the Green Lane between Llangefni and Newborough.

8 The Côt (including the Benches, Cwt Glas and Maes Parcio).

There was a full discussion on the following issues:

- 8.1. **Cwt Glas** - following the report that was given and the decision made at the last meeting, the Chairman had been tasked to meet with an Engineer from Natural Resources Wales but due to circumstances outside his control, this had not been possible on the date that had been arranged. However, he had spoken with another team member who is familiar with the area and was informed that the site is not their responsibility nor has it been registered with the HM Land Registry. Therefore, as this is not their asset, they would not be prepared to fund any scheme to rectify the subsidence issues. In concluding his report, the Chair was very concerned and that the Community Council had a Health & Safety responsibility for the site. Cllr Mr Gwilym Looms voiced his concerns over the responsibility and insuring of the site and that the Community Council does not have the finances to pay for such repairs.

Following further discussion, it was proposed and seconded (AH/MD) that the Clerk contacts Mr Dafydd G Jones who played an integral part in creating and securing funding for the site in order to provide more background information and report back to the next meeting.

In response the Clerk was very concerned that the actual site was not included in the Community Council's Insurance Policy and that the NRW were not prepared to carry out a structural survey. He, therefore, suggested that the Community Council approaches Mr Rowland Thomas, the IOACC Flood Alleviation Officer for his advice and guidance. *This suggestion was proposed and seconded (AH/GL).*

8.2 **Benches** – a quotation had been received from Mr Dan Sayer of Wild Elements Woodwork. *Following discussion, it was proposed and seconded that the Community Council accept the quotation but without the need to proceed and install flower planters (AH/GL).*

8.3 **Transfer of the Cob Car Park** - it was noted that there was uncertainty as to the ownership of the site and that it had not been registered with the HMRC Land Registry. *Motion & Second not to proceed with considering transferring the site for the time being due to costs the Community Council (AH/PD) may face.*

9 The Council's Training Plan.

It was noted that the Clerk will inform members of the courses at the beginning of the New Year.

10 Dog Dispensers and Bags.

The Clerk confirmed that the 2 Dog Dispensers that need to be installed in Hermon have been received and that 2 further dispensers to be located on each side along the Cob has been purchased but it will be necessary to receive assurances that waste bins will be available close to the dispensers in order to avoid any health and safety complaints before proceeding further.

11 Cemetery Issues.

The Clerk reported that he had begun to organize the tendering process for the Grass Cutting Agreement for both the Old & New Cemeteries in Trefdraeth for 2024 in order to assist with the Setting of the Budget for 2024/2025 and it is expected that he will have received the prices by the next meeting.

12 Allotment Matters.

The Clerk said that all allotment payments had been resolved and paid.

13 Footpath Matters.

It was reported Cllrs Mrs Pat Dobbie, Mr Les Thomas & Mr Selwyn Williams had walked the Paths following concerns raised and discussed at the Footpaths Meeting held on the 17th October 2023. Cllr Dobbie agreed to prepare a full report by the next meeting. Cllr Thomas & Cllr Williams both reported that the path at Feisdon is in a poor condition and that the overhanging overgrowth needs urgent attention. *Following a quick discussion, it was agreed to engage with a local Contractor to obtain a quotation to cut this path as soon as possible.*

14 Highways Matters.

The following were noted:

14.1 **Road Safety Strategy Consultation** - encourage all Councilors to complete the consultation before the closing date - 31 January 2024.

14.2 **Temporary Traffic Prohibition Order (B4422 Lôn Bethel to Bodorgan Station)** on 10th October 2023 to enable the installation of a micro dish on top of the mast.

14.3 **Traffic Prohibition Order Temporary (Lôn Tre Ddafydd Uchaf, Bodorgan)** between 13th & 15th November 2023 to enable replacement of faulty poles and cable activity on behalf of Openreach.

14.4 **Temporary Traffic Prohibition Order (Lôn Stesion Bodorgan)** between 16th & 18th November 2023 in order to enabling the renewal of defective poles and cable activity on behalf of Openreach.
